First Steps to Rights introduces young children aged 3-7 years to the basic rights of all children across the world - family, home, food, water and play — as contained in the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child.

This book of activities and the accompanying photographs help practitioners to bring a global perspective to exploring these rights in a concrete way.

It is based on methodology developed via the successful First Steps project led by the Centre for Global Awareness (Hampshire Development Education Centre).

Activities are designed for whole class or group work, and are aimed at pre-school/nursery and reception (3-5), Year 1 (5-6) and Year 2 (6-7).





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
