

Session Plan KS1 (15-30 minutes)

Is school the most important thing during a war?



Timing	Activity	Slide(s)
2 minutes	Introduction: Introduce the VoteTopic and look at the picture, can the children answer the question.	2
4-8 minutes	What makes a school? Using the images ask the children to think about what they need in a school. On slide 5 reveal the information and read the boxes. What do the children think?	4-5
4-8 minutes	What is happening in Yemen? Firstly begin by using the slide to describe where Yemen is and what is happening there. On slide 8 discuss with them that many schools have been destroyed and ask them how they would feel if they couldn't go to school.	7-8
4-8 minutes	How does war change peoples lives? Using the pictures can the children come up with some ways that a war could change a child's life. Use slide 11 to discuss this further.	10-11
5 minutes	How does war change children's lives? This is a chance for the children to think about all the things that they would miss if they couldn't go to school. Then using the slider ask the children to say where they think education is on the scale of importance.	12-13
2-3 minutes	Yes/No summary: Pupils consider the 2 different sides before voting.	14
