Do you know your history?

			
1 min	Feedback	Whole class	Look at the results from last week's topic.
2-3 mins	1. Starter: Who are you?	Pair	Consider the important things or people in their lives that help make them who they are.
1-2 mins	2. Why are we talking about this?	Whole class	Explore why we are discussing this topic.
6-12 mins	3. The same but different!	Whole class	Walk around the class and find out more about their classmates' history. Then discuss how everyone is different, which is why we learn about different people and places in school.
5-10 mins	4. Does it help?	Whole class	Look at the different ways school helps them to learn about their history and use their thumbs to show if they think it helps or not.
8-15 mins	5. Black History	Pair/Whole class	Consider the importance of Black History being varied and look at different Black role models and what could be learned from them.
N/A	Vote	Whole class	Review the Yes/No arguments for this topic before casting their vote.
5+ mins	Extension: Who am I?	Individual	Create a poster that represents who they think they are and celebrates what makes them unique.
