1 min	Feedback	Whole class	Look at the results from last week's topic.
2-4 mins	1. Starter: odd one out	Whole class	Look at each series of pictures and spot which one is the odd one out.
1 mins	2. Why are we talking about this?	Whole class	Explore why we are discussing this topic.
5-8 mins	3. Like everybody else?	Whole class	Discuss what groups they are a part of before looking at different statements and going to the left if it relates to them, and the right if it doesn't – how is everyone different?
5-8 mins	4. What should I do?	Whole class /Pair	Have a look at some examples where children are trying to fit in and give them advice, based on the suggestions.
3-5 mins	5. What do you think?	Whole class	Read the different statements and raise their hand if it relates to them.
N/A	Vote	Whole class	Review the Yes/No arguments for this topic before casting their vote.
5+ mins	Extension: I promise...	Individual	Based on the anti-bullying video, make promises about what they'll do to stop bullying.
